**Please note that some cases of head lice have been discovered at Hansen Elementary.** The spread of head lice can be controlled with prompt diagnosis and effective preventative treatment.

The first thing you can do to help prevent the spread of lice is to discuss the subject openly with your family. Lice can affect anyone, regardless of background or hygiene. If everyone knows what's going on, the risk of infestation can be cut in half.

Lice cannot fly or jump, and they are normally transferred during direct head to head contact. Remind your child(ren) to be aware of their surroundings and not to share items that touch their heads, like hats, headphones, helmets, etc.

Check your child's hair for evidence of head lice. You can help prevent the spread of head lice by checking your child(ren) daily for the next few weeks. If you suspect your child has lice, please notify the school at 423-5475. Local stores carry special shampoos designed specifically to treat head lice. Check with your family doctor or a pharmacist if you need more information.

Tenga en cuenta que algunos casos de piojos de la cabeza se han descubierto en esta primaria de Hansen. La primera cosa que puede hacer para ayudar a prevenir la cabeza de la propagacion de los piojos es discutir el tema abiertamente con su familia. Los piojos pueden afectar a cualquier persona independientemente de su origen o hygiene y si todo el mundo sabe lo que esta pasando en el riesgo de infestación puede ser reducido a la mitad. Los piojos no pueden volar o saltar y normalente son transferidos durante el contacto directo de cabeza a cabeza. Recuerde a sus hijos para que sean conscientes de su entorno y no compartir objetos que tocan la cabeza como sombreros, revise el cabello de su hijo para la evidencia de piojos de la cabeza puede ayudar a prevenir la propogacion de los piojos dela cabeza por el control de sus hijos diariamente par alas proximas semanas.
